## PATROL LEADER CONTRACT

- 7. Keep my patrol members informed of all important patrol information.

- 9. Attend, be on time and ready for meetings and Troop activities, and tell the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) as soon as I know that I can't make a meeting or event.
- 10. Wear the proper uniform at Troop meetings and events.
- 11. Help other scouts whenever possible and be especially supportive of younger and less experienced scouts.
- 12. Have fun and help other scouts have fun too!
- 13. Set an appointment with the Scoutmaster when nearing the end of my tenure as Junior Assistant Scoutmaster to review my success in meeting the commitments set forth in this position contract.
